Headlands is a 100-foot high bluff of land overlooking a lower beach plain. The dashed trails are groomed for skiing. No snowmobiling is allowed. Parking is just inside the Headlands entry.

The dark blue trail takes you to a gorgeous overlook of the Straits.

The orange trail goes down the bluff and has a 200 foot section at a 12% grade.

Across the street from the Headlands is Mackinaw's Historic Village. The solid trails are used by snowmobiles and skiers.
